PROGRAM

Friday was the Lincoln South annual scholarship competition. Each year one scholarship for \$1,000 and one for \$500 are awarded to students from area high schools in south Lincoln. Guidance counselors from each school select nominees who submit a personal data sheet detailing their high school activities, community volunteer contributions and demonstrated leadership as well as a short essay explaining why community service is important to them. Four finalists are selected by a scholarship committee and the finalists present speeches to the club and answer follow up questions. The club is asked to judge the finalists not only on their speeches but also on their demonstrated leadership and community volunteer contributions as reflected on the personal data provided by each finalist. Each finalist as well as the counselors from the schools received a bag of gifts. Thanks to the members and their companies listed below who donated the gifts.

The four finalists who competed for the 2 scholarships were Zachary Mapes from Southwest High School, Allison Schorr from Lincoln East High School and Kelsey Ankerson and Ashton Nieveen both from Norris High School.

Congratulations to Allison Schorr who won the first place \$1,000 scholarship and to Kelsey Ankerson and Zachary Mapes who tied for the 2nd place \$500 scholarship which was split between them.
